INSURANCE OR HMO

Most insurance companies cover drug and alcohol treatment. Contact your company to determine what is covered and how to properly access this benefit. In some cases, pre-authorization from the HMO is required. Some drug and alcohol facilities will assist you In working with your insurance company.

VETERANS BENEFITS

Most military veterans are eligible for drug and alcohol treatment services.
